PLEASE NOTE: MAJOR CHANGES TO TERMS & CONDITIONS

Incentive Campdraft Terms & Conditions

Incentive Campdrafts will not be ACA affiliated but run under NCC rules.

Horse that meet the conditions can compete ONCE a year in only one of either the Future Champions, Aged Champions, or the Donrica Gelding Incentive Campdrafts.

Horses and owners will only be eligible for the incentive drafts prize money if ALL of the following conditions are complied with:

- Horses can only compete twice under the same ownership.
- Horses can only compete if purchased from 2010 onwards.
- ALL competitors will need to be FULL or TEMPORARY Australian Stock Horse Society members in order to compete at the campdraft. Temporary day memberships will be available to purchase \$40/adult competitor but must be purchased PRIOR to competing.
- Purchased horses must be transferred into the purchaser's name and remain in the purchasers name to be eligible.
- Horses registered ASHS name & registration number MUST BE entered when nominating.
- Horses must compete in the correct age category where specified. Verification of age must be supplied or determined if requested. A horse's birth date is taken as the 1st August.
- Entries must be completed by the owner when entering horses in the Dalby ASH Sale Incentive Drafts or any prize money will be paid to person nominating horse.
- Geldings of any age can nominate for the Donrica Stock Horse Stud Gelding Incentive. Horses that compete in the gelding incentive must be ridden by the owner or immediate family (Example: Wife, Son, Daughter). If horses enter into the Gelding Incentive, they are not able to enter into Aged Champion or Future Champion Incentive Campdrafts in the same year.
- Any horse that has won an incentive draft is not eligible to return under the same ownership.
- Incentive drafts consist of two (2) full rounds. Places are paid on aggregate scores.
- The status of horses will change according to the highest status horse in the event.
- Any horse presented for sale, but not sold, may be eligible for the Incentive Drafts if the vendor pays the Agent's commission on the value reached at the point of being passed in. The commission must be payed within 48 hours of the completion of the sale.
- A 'passed in' horse is eligible if it is purchased and lodged with the agent within 48 hours of the completion of the sale.

The Committee reserves the right to alter the program and/or any terms and conditions.

Open Incentive Terms & Conditions

1. **Nominations will be via Campdraft Central opening Monday 31st October at 7:30pm.**
2. Scratching received on the 27th November 2016 from 8.00am to 8.00am 29th November 2016 will forfeit a \$15 fee. Scratching received after 8.00am 29th November 2016 will forfeit the whole amount of nominations.
3. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at the Campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$50 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$50 fee is forfeited.
4. All competitors under 18 years must wear a skullcap at all times when mounted in the arena.
5. In the event that your power arrangement causes fault to the electrical supply and requires an electrician to visit the grounds the person responsible for the fault may be responsible for paying the electrician should it be deemed that your power arrangements were negligent. .
6. **Riders must be ASHS Members – Temporary Membership will be available on the weekend (\$40/per rider per day).**

- Owner/s of competing horse must be full ASHS financial members in order for their horse to compete.
- Horses registered ASHS name & registration number MUST BE entered when nominating.
- Horses must compete in the correct age category where specified. Verification of age must be supplied or determined if requested. A horse's birth date is taken as the 1st August.
- Entries must be completed by the owner when entering horses in the Dalby ASH Sale Incentive Drafts or any prize money will be paid to person nominating horse.
- A 'passed in' horse is eligible if it is purchased and lodged with the agent within 48 hours of the completion of the sale.

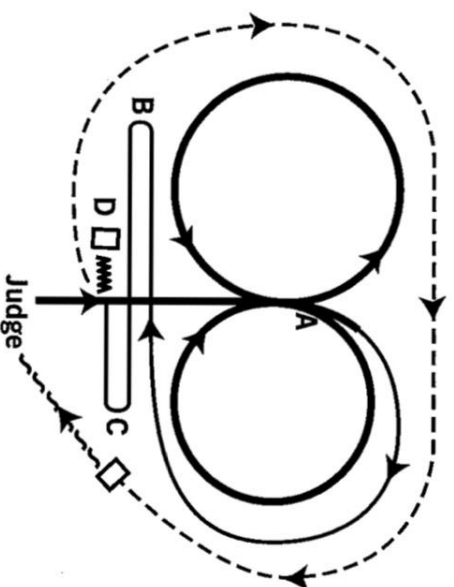

Working Pattern - W5



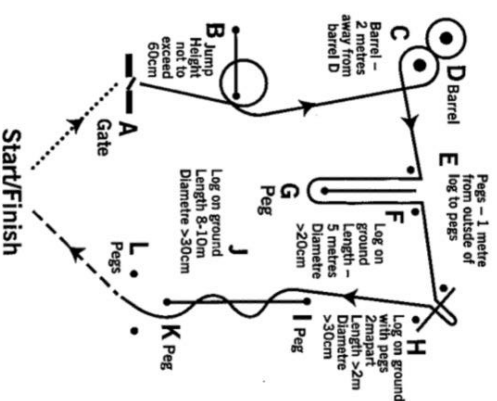
	POSSIBLE POINTS	ALL OCATED POINTS
1 Type, Presentation and Overall Impression	10	
2 From Judge Hand Gallop to A. At A circle right	10	
3 At A Flying change left, Hand Gallop circle to A	10	
4 At A Flying change right, Canter three quarter circle right, continue to B	10	
5 At B Haunch turn left and Canter to C	10 x 2 (20)	
6 At C Haunch turn right and Canter to D	10 x 2 (20)	
7 At D Stop, settle and back up 4 metres, then settle	10	
8 Trot right round work pattern to C	10	
9 At C Stop, Walk back to Judge on a loose rein	10	
TOTAL	110

Time Trial Pattern TT3



Course

- Commence course between the start/finish pegs at a Walk, Walk to gate at A. Once the rider's hand touches the gate, the horse may continue the course at any pace to the pegs at L
- Open the gate, pass through and close the gate - the gate latch must be securely fastened
- Continue past the jump at B, leaving the jump on the near side of the horse. Turn and jump over the jump, continue to circle around the end of the jump to the barrel at C
- Leave barrel C on the near side of the horse, circle anti-clockwise half a circle around barrel C, circle barrel D clockwise a full circle and then circle C anti-clockwise half a circle to complete figure of eight (Note: two metre distance between the edges of Barrel C and D). Continue to the pegs at E
- Leave the first peg on the off side of the horse, complete a 90° turn to the right and continue along the length of log at F
- At the end of log F, turn 180° around peg G to the left and continue along the other side of log F. Leaving the second peg at E on the off side of the horse, turn 90° and continue towards H

- At H, jump the log between the pegs, turn the horse 180° to the right and jump the log again between the pegs. Continue to I
- Jump log J three times in a serpentine motion. Starting with peg on left, between the pegs I and K. Continue to L, reducing the pace of the horse to a Trot prior to crossing a line between pegs at L (Note: 1 metre distance between the L pegs)
- Then continue at a Trot to start/finish pegs. Horse must Trot between the start/finish pegs to complete the course

Rules

- The time commences and terminates when the horse's nose crosses the line between the start/finish pegs
- A one (1) second penalty will be incurred for each stride that is broken in the Walk and Trot sections
- A three (3) second penalty will be incurred when the jump B barrel C or D, or pegs E, G, H, I, K or L are knocked over
- When jumping the log at H and J, the horse's four feet must touch the ground on the other side of the obstacle before returning over the log. Failure to do so will result in elimination
- A horse will be eliminated for not completely and correctly negotiating any section of the course
- Head restraints are not permitted
- The Walk section must be a four beat pace Walk. Penalties will be incurred for any break in beat
- A one (1) second penalty will be incurred for each hoof which crosses the log at F
- Penalties will be added to the time and the time will become the score for this section
- The horse with the lowest score will be determined as the winner

Safety

For safety, if logs of less than the designated diameters are not available, then logs MUST be securely pinned to the ground, in order to prevent all movement

Note

In their age group riders under 13 years of age must open the gate but do not have to close it
