# OPEN CAMPDRAFT and FUTURITY CAMPDRAFTS and CHALLENGE TERMS

- Campdrafts run under NCC rules.
- Challenges run under ASCA rules.
- **Horses and owners will only be eligible for prize money if ALL of the following conditions are complied with:**
  - ALL competitors will need to be Current Financial Australian Stock Horse Society or ACA members in order to compete at the campdraft (If Not Temporary Membership will need to be purchased prior to competing) Stockmans Challenge Competitors will require to have current ASCA Membership.
  - **Horses must compete in the correct age category where specified. Verification of age must be supplied or determined if requested. A horse's birth date is taken as the 1st August.**
  - Any prize money will be paid to person nominating horse.
  - **The status of horse will change according to the highest status horse in the OPEN event.**
  - Scratchings received 23rd August onwards will forfeit the entire nomination fee.
  - **Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint in relation to an Event, must lodge the complaint in writing to the Secretary of the DDASHS Branch within one hour of the incident taking place. Refer Section 24 of the ASHS handbook. A fee of \$50 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by The DDASHS Branch, the \$50 fee is forfeited.**
  - All rules as per relevant associations must be adhered to at all times, Competitors responsibility to read and understand rules and regulations prior to competing.
  - **All competitors under 18 years must wear a skullcap at all times when mounted on the grounds.**
  - Stallions containment regulations to be adhered to.
  - **The Committee reserves the right to alter the program and/or any terms and conditions**
  - Changes need to be to the secretary's office within 1 hour of event starting
  - **Darling Downs Rider awards are for riders residing in the Darling Downs region by postcode, please ensure details are correct in Campdraft Central.**
  - Corona Cup Award is for DDASHS active branch members only.
  - **Open Challenge Incentive for horses who been through Dalby Sale since 2010, can have changed ownership please notify office staff if your horse is eligible for the DDASHS to check their records.**
  - In the event that your power arrangement causes fault to the electrical supply and requires an electrician to visit the grounds the person responsible for the fault may be responsible for paying the electrician should it be deemed that your power arrangements were negligent.
  - **Full payment to be received by August 13th**
  - All Competitors will need to complete a horse health declaration. This will need to be handed to the secretary's office.
  - **All competitors will need to present to the secretary's office to receive a competitors armband. This will be provided once confirmation of all paperwork including payment of nominations, current memberships, horse health declarations and COVID checkin confirmed. A competitor will not be able to enter the camp or challenge arena without this armband**
- **The Event will run under a COVID Safe Event Plan and all attendees must check in via the QR Code at the gate.**

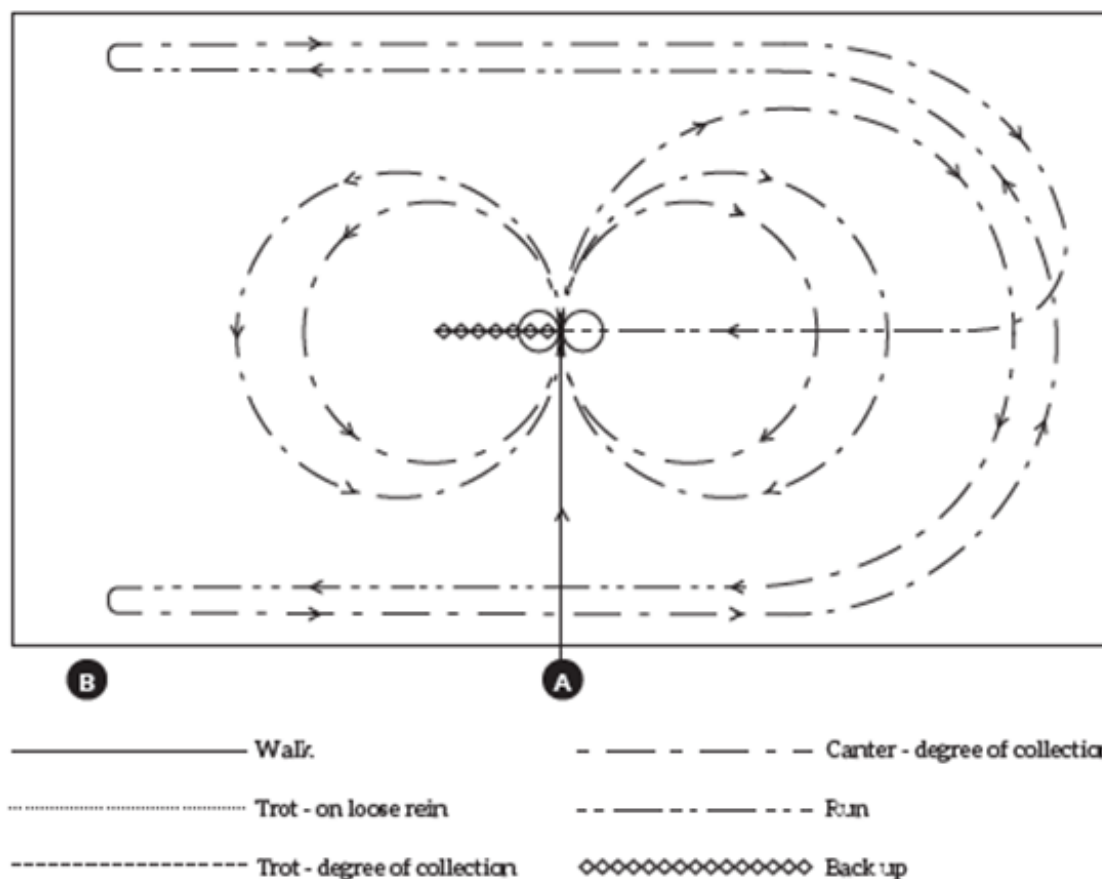

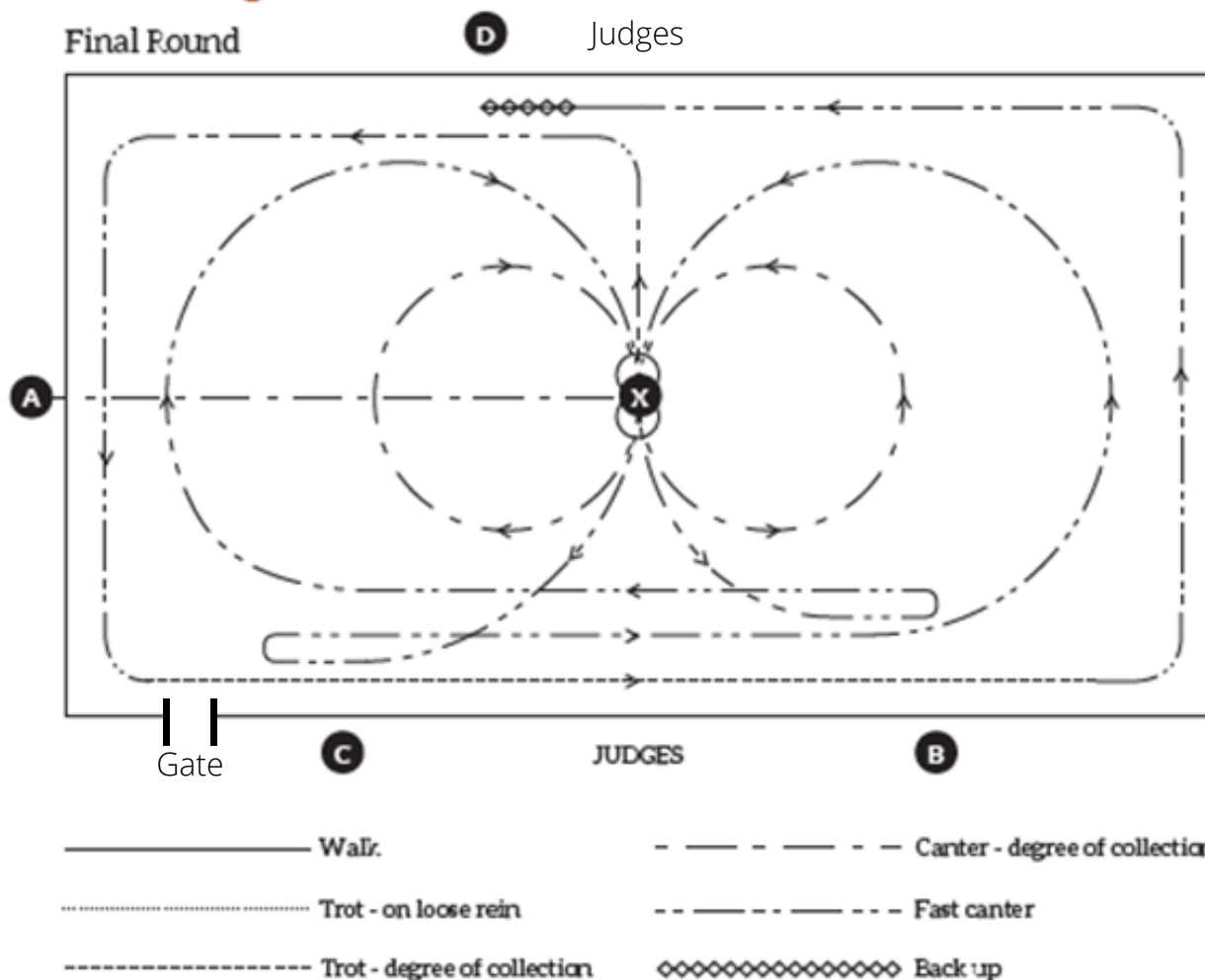

# Derby/Classic/Rookie/Juvenile First Round Challenge Pattern



1	Enter arena at A, acknowledge judge, walk to centre on loose rein cracking whip.
2	2 spins right.
3	2 spins left
4	Canter small slow circle to right. Canter large fast circle to right.
5	Flying change. Canter large fast circle to left.
6	Canter small slow circle to left.
7	Flying change. Canter large circle to right, do not close circle.
8	Run down and stop between centreline and B, rollback to left, canter around arena.
9	Run down and stop between centreline and C, rollback to right, canter to end of arena, turn down centre line.
10	Run down and stop at least 3 metres past centreline, settle horse, back up to centre, acknowledge judge, leave arena at walk on a loose rein.

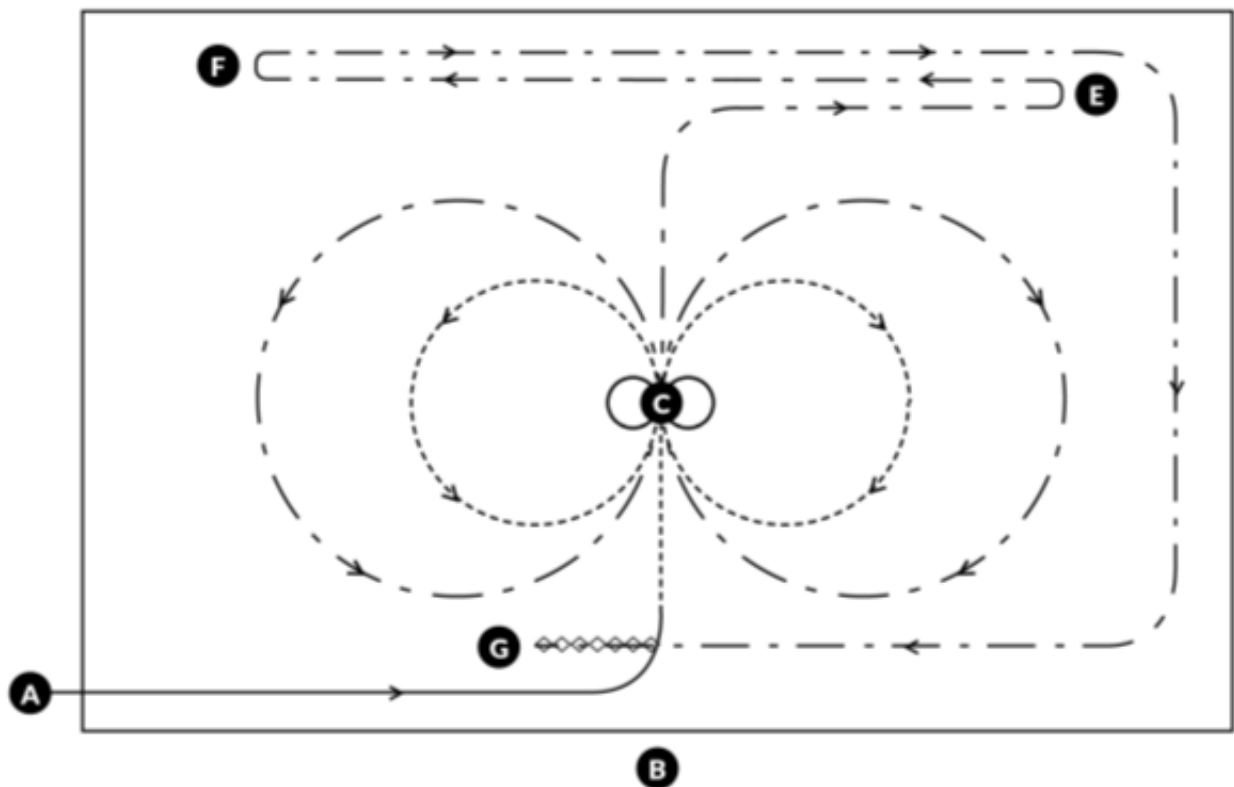
# Open First Round & Open / Derby / Classic / Rookie Final Challenge Pattern



1	Enter at A, fast canter to X Halt, hesitate
2	At X, 3 spins right
3	3¼ spins left
4	Fast canter large circle to the left-do not close circle
5	At B stop, roll back to right
6	Continue to X at fast canter
7	Fast canter large circle to the right-do not close circle
8	At C stop, roll back to left
9	Continue to X at fast canter
10	At X canter a slow small circle to left with a degree of collection
11	Flying change at X
12	Canter slow small circle with a degree of collection to the right
13	Flying change at X
14	At X, fast canter to C on the left lead
15	At C, trot to B
16	At B fast canter to D
17	Between D and corner marker stop
18	Settle horse
19	Back over tracks until level with X
20	Face and salute Judges
21	Leave arena at a working walk, cracking whip on a loose rein
22	Overall presentation, horsemanship, fluency and continuity between sections and impression of free-flowing movements of pattern

1	Saulte Judge at A
2	Walk to B
3	Rising trot to C (center). Stop.
4	360° spin to the right.
5	360° spin to the left.
6	Trot a medium circle to the right.
7	Trot a medium circle to the left.
8	At C canter a large circle to the right on the right lead.
9	At C do a simple change and canter a large circle to the left on the left lead.
10	At C do a simple change and canter to E on the right lead. Stop.
11	Do a rollback to the left and canter to F on the left lead. Stop.
12	Do a rollback to the right and canter on the right lead all the way to G and stop.
13	Back your horse until you are in line with the judge. Stop.
14	Turn and face the judge, salute. Leave arena on a loose rein.
